Event 2 ARDF Style Road Event

Start Location: **-37 55.3058 S 140 56.8699 E**

Time: 1300 - 1500

Frequency: 146.525

This event is based on an ARDF foot event. 4 Transmitters on the same frequency will transmit 30sec on, 90sec off each in sequence so that only one transmitter is on at a time. Each transmitter will be uniquely identified by a morse code ident. Competitors will be released one at a time at 2min intervals, to prevent follow the leader and start congestion. Competitors waiting to depart will not be allowed to enter their vehicles until 15sec prior to their departure time. Time of departure will be recorded as will the time of arrival at the designated finish line. All competitors will be required to record information at each site to prove they have found each of the 4 transmitters. Other tokens may also be employed. The transmitters can be found in any order. Competitors may be required to carry a GPS logger on their vehicles. Competitors are required to restrict themselves to 100km/hr. Competitors achieving identical times will be scored as equal.

Start Location: **-37 48.3482 S 140 43.8196 E**

Time: 1330 - 1530

Frequency: **Leg 1 146.525 Leg 2 52.100 Leg 3 3.585 Leg 4 1296.000**

Note : **At the completion of Event 6 all competitors must present their SI sticks for scoring purposes back at the start of this Event** before going off to freshen up before the Presentations. This will ensure that the scoring can be completed in time. Failure to do this may result in missing out on the points of the day's events

Important Note: Changing of antennas less than 50 metres from the last fox found may incur a 30 second penalty

Info :

- All waypoints are in Degrees / Decimal Minutes
- If you are late turning up for an event, you must start from when you arrive. The start of the next event will not wait for you. More than 5min late may result in a penalty.
- **Any forest road that has a road closed sign or bunting across must not be accessed.**
- The forests now have cameras set up everywhere and if you are in one of the closed OFF areas you will be fined by the forest owner.
- **Last minute changes may apply** due to weather, equipment or road closures.
